Position Summary

Under the direction of the Director of Campus of Care, the Coordinator of the Day Health Program is responsible for the support and direction of the Day Health program interdisciplinary Team.

Direct Reports: Day Health Clinical Staff including Art Therapists, Recreation Therapists, Counsellors, and Music therapists.

Key Responsibilities

The Coordinator of the Day Health Program is responsible for the following:

- Hiring, supporting and supervising staff in the Day Health Program including Therapies and Counselling.
- Screening and delegating the supervision of students.
- Delegating the support of volunteers within the program.
- Managing the budget related to Equipment and Supplies.
- Scheduling staff (with assistance of AO) and managing leaves.



- Safety and maintenance of the various areas (Art Studio, Music Studio, Fitness room and Counselling rooms).
- Coordinating Participants admission to the Day Health Program.
- Regularly acts as Team Leader.
- Acts as a Liaison with other Departments.
- Other duties as assigned.

Education, Qualifications and Experience

The preferred education, qualifications and experience of the Day Health Coordinator are:

- Diploma or Degree in a related discipline.
- 2 years supervisory experience.
- Experience and education in HIV/AIDS, multi-diagnosis care, mental health or substance use settings is an asset.
- Skills in conflict resolution, behavior management, and restorative justice.
- Understanding of challenges experienced by individuals living with HIV and significant health and social issues, including homelessness, mental illness, trauma, substance use, poverty, and social isolation is preferred.

General Working Conditions

This is a full-time position with an annual pay rate range of \$84,728 to \$101,751. This position requires flexibility and the ability to prioritize workload, and the ability to work in a fast-paced environment where demands and deadlines may change with short notice. Multitasking and flexibility are a must in order to meet deadlines, and to support many operational functions/activities that may occur concurrently or without notice. An understanding of the importance of maintaining the confidentiality of sensitive employee/client information is necessary.
